STANDARDISATION OF ACCOUTREMENTS - NAVAL PARADES

- 1. Naval ceremonial parades generally comprise of a ceremonial guard alongwith armed/ unarmed platoons and personnel on parade wear Dress No. 1/2/8A. Presently, orders on uniforms for personnel on parade are promulgated locally, resulting in non-standardized uniforms/ accourtements and appearance.
- 2. Measures elucidated below have been approved by the Competent Authority to usher in uniformity and standardisation.
- 3. <u>Dress for Guard and Armed Platoon at Naval Parades/ Ceremonies</u>. The uniform for the Guard and Armed Platoons during ceremonial parades will continue to be Dress No. 1/2/8A. Ceremonial Kamarbandh, white Rexine Belt (with brass buckle), Navy Blue Sash (for Markers/ Darshaks) and Jhalar are to be worn along with the above uniforms. The practice of officers wearing black gaiters is to be discontinued. Officers and sailors are to wear white Spats.
- 4. Details of specification and usage of Ceremonial Kamarbandh, White Rexine Belt, Navy Blue Sash and Jhalar have been promulgated separately.
