 - (ii) Desirable qualification

- (b) Age (with applicable relaxations as per extant regulations)
 - (c) Pay band
 - (d) Grade pay
 - (e) Nature of Duties in brief.
- 3. <u>Mode of Selection (including methodology for screening/shortlisting of applications, as applicable)</u>.
- 4. <u>Physical Standards</u>.
- 5. <u>Details of Endurance/ Skill Test (if any)</u>.
- 6. <u>Syllabus</u>. The syllabi for the preparation of the question papers necessarily needs to be indicated for information of the candidates.
