- S.R.O. 51:—In exercise of the powers conferred by the provise to article 309 of the Constitution of India and in supersession of the Group 'C' (Electronic Data Processing Posts) Recruitment Rules, 1996, in so far as they relate to Data Entry Operator Grade 'C', except as respects things done or omitted to be done before such supersession, the President hereby makes the following rules regulating the method of recruitment to Group 'B' Electronic Data Processing posts in Integrated Headquarters, Ministry of Defence (Navy) namely:—
- Short title and commencement.—(1) These rules may be called the Integrated Headquarturs. Ministry of Defence (Navy) Group 'B' Non-Gazetted, (Electronic Data Processing Posts) Recruitment Rules, 2013.
  - (2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.
- 2. Number of posts, classification, pay band and grade pay/scales of pay.—The number of the gusts, their classification, pay band and grade pay/scales of pay attached thereto shall be as specified in columns (2) to (4) of the said Schedule.
- Method of recruitment, age limit, other qualifications, etc...—The method of recruitment, age limit, qualifications
  and other matters relating thereto shall be as specified in columns (5) to (13) of the said Schedule.
  - 4. Disqualification.—No person,—
  - (a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living; or
  - (b) who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person,

shall be eligible for appointment to the said posts:

Provided that the Central Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

- 5. Power to relax.—Where the Central Government is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient to do so, it may, by order and for reasons to be recorded in writing, and in consultation with the Union Public Service Commission, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.
- 6. Saving.—Nothing in these rules shall affect reservations, relaxation of age-limit and other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes, the Scheduled Tribes, ex-servicemen and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.

Note 1: The departmental officers in the feeder category who are in the direct line of promotion will not be eligible for consideration for appointment on deputation. Similarly, deputationists shall not be eligible for consideration for appointment by promotion.

Note 2: Period of deputation including period of deputation in another ex-cadre post held immediately preceding this appointment in the same or some other organisation/ department of the Central Government shall ordinarily not to exceed three years. The maximum age limit for appointment by deputation shall be not exceeding 56 years as on the closing date of receipt of applications.

Note 3: For purposes of appointment on deputation basis, the service rendered on a regular basis by an officer prior to 1st January 2006, (the date from which the revised pay structure based on the 6th Central Pay Commission recommendation has been extended), shall be deemed to be service rendered in the corresponding grade pay/psy scale extended based on the recommendations of the Pay Commission except where there has been merger of more than one pre-revised scale of pay into one grade with a common grade pay/pay scale, and where this benefit will extend only for the post(s) for which that grade pay/pay scale, is the normal replacement grade without any upgradation.
